5) Textbooks Faculty Alliance has begun a discussion of how and when textbooks are chosen and why students may have trouble getting the correct textbooks. We also passed a motion encouraging faculty to chartshe costs associated with different textbooks in their decisions to adopt specific books for their classeswellates with the most faculty already consider the costs to students when choosing a textbook.

In summary, the Faculty Allia addiessing issues of importance to our students and faculty. We are working especially hard on improving our students' experience at UA by streamlining procedures, clarifications, ensuring-highlity courses, and investigating ways to save students time, effort, and money.
