

Resolution 2014-03 General Education Requirements Coordination Task Force

Whereas, on April 4, 2014, the UA Board of Regents passed a resolution concerning UA charge the faculty

across the UA system to develop and adopt common general education and developmental/preparatory learning outcomes and requirements and, as a first step in this process to develop and implement common learning outcomes, course descriptions, numbers and titles, and common placement tools and scores for math and English and propose a plan of implementation for other areas of general education (humanities and fine arts, natural sciences, and social sciences) by fall 2016;" and

Whereas, the Faculty Alliance agrees with the Board of Regents that the curricular revisions

faculty; and

Whereas, the Faculty Alliance supports the work of existing statewide and local faculty groups in reviewing and revising General Education Requirements;

The UA Faculty Alliance constitutes a UA GER Coordination Task Force consisting of three faculty representatives appointed by the Faculty Senates of UAS, UAA, and UAF (nine members total), and charges it with the following tasks:

- 1. To propose a shared structure for GERs at the three universities and explain how this
- 2. To propose new language for university regulation, if necessary, to accommodate the proposed common structure, and
- 3. To recommend new policy for the BOR to consider for GERs.

Deadlines: Interim report to the Faculty Alliance in April 2015. Final report November 2015.
